PARAGOULD YOUTH BASEBALL/SOFTBALL PLAYING RULES 3-4 YEAR OLD TEE BALL

GENERAL RULES

- 1. A player may play in an older age group, but under no circumstances will a player be allowed to play in an age group younger than their own.
- 2. Player requests are limited to three per team; the head coach and two assistant coaches.
- 3. Metal cleats are not permitted in 12 year old and younger.
- 4. Crowd control is the responsibility of first, the coach, secondly, the umpires, and thirdly, the league sports director. Fans demonstrating disruptive behavior will be asked to leave. Police may be called in an effort to restore a family-friendly environment at Bland Park and Rotary Park.

3-4 YEAR OLD TEE BALL

- 1. 3-4 year olds will hit off of a tee. The batting order will be round robin. After all players in the batting order have batted, the offense will become the defense.
- 2. All players will be positioned on defense. No player will sit out.
- 3. All games will have a 45 minute time limit. No score will be kept.
